Please send this packet on to the next person on the route in 10 days at the most. If you are too busy to contribute in this time period, just send it on with only a note of explanation. If you have this RR "resting" at your place, due to life's little twists and turns, please don't be embarrassed! Just let your RM know, so she/he will not re-start it, thinking it is lost. That causes great confusion and costly double packets of letters. Placing enough postage on the RR's is also very important. Some Post Offices will not deliver mail that does not have enough postage. To be safe, if a RR has 5 pages or more, you should use a ~~49~~ cent stamp and a ~~35~~ cent stamp (at least until the postage goes up).

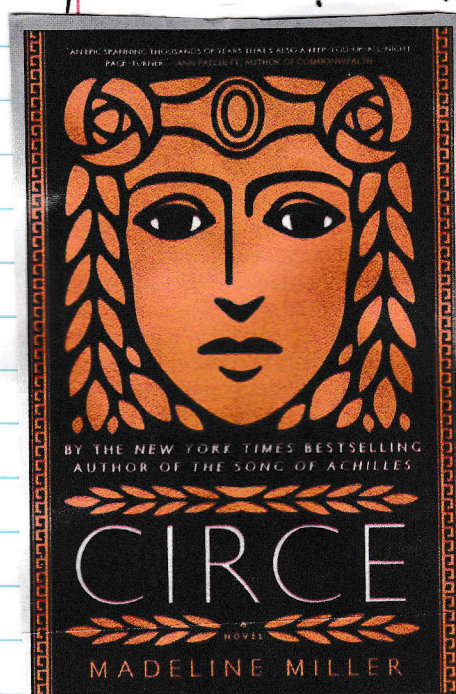

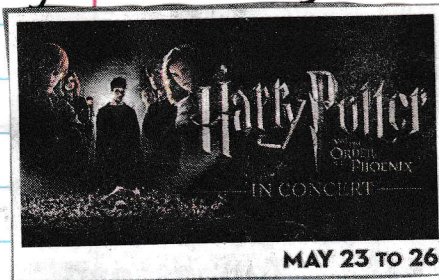
But Circe unwittingly draws the wrath of both men and gods. She must summon her strength and choose whether she belongs with the gods, or with the mortals she has come to love.

very, interesting one pointing out deep questions ... I'm



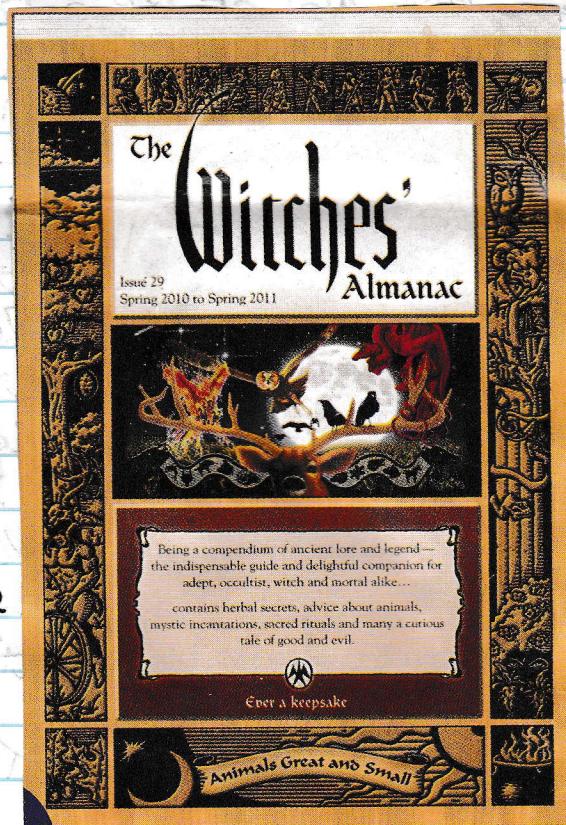
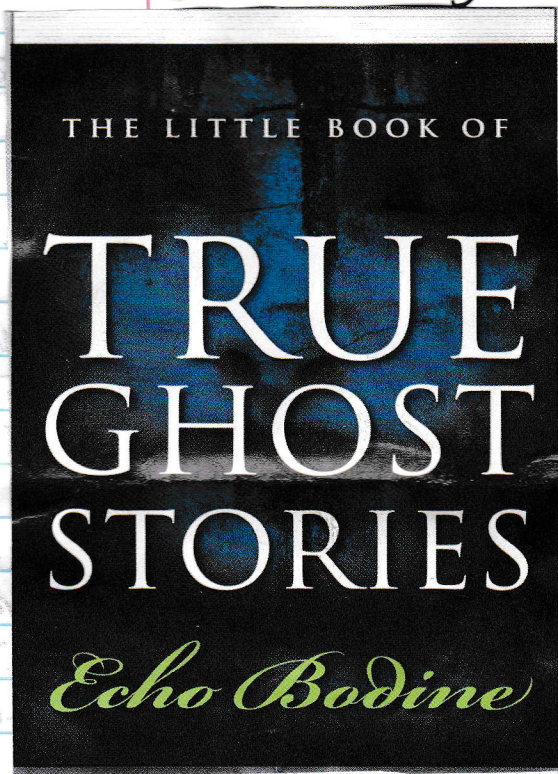
Surprised; although maybe I shouldn't
